\*Businesses must qualify as Conditionally Exempt Small Quantity Generators (CESQG). A CESQG is a business that does not generate more than 220 lbs. of hazardous waste or 2.2 lbs. of acutely hazardous waste each month or store more than 2,200 lbs. (approximately four 55-gallon drums) of hazardous waste at any time. Exclusions may apply for universal waste.

Marshall County Solid Waste reserves the right to limit quantities and/or frequency of visits. Although we do not accept explosive waste (such as ammunition, fireworks, or flares), radioactive waste (such as smoke alarms), or controlled substances, residents are encouraged to call our office for disposal guidance.
