(approximately four 55-gallon drums) of hazardous waste at any time. Exclusions may apply for universal waste.

Marshall County Solid Waste reserves the right to limit quantities and/or frequency of visits. Although we do not accept explosive waste (such as ammunition, fireworks, or flares), radioactive waste (such as smoke alarms), or controlled substances, residents are encouraged to call our office for disposal guidance.
